May 4, 2019 Affiliate Local Best Practices (73335): This workshop will cover best practices of successful locals; including setting goals, communications, political activity, community involvement and basic union administration. It will also cover basic Secretary roles and responsibilities including document retention, taking minutes, and membership database. Finally, it will cover the financial roles and responsibilities of the Treasurer, including step by step instructions on building a budget. This workshop is ideal for leaders of newly affiliated locals or for those that find themselves in a position of leadership without the benefit of a succession plan.
